LWC Safety Committee is Upgrading Our **COMMUNITY RADIO SERVICE**

WHAT'S HAPPENING?

- We're setting up a radio control station in the "Crow's Nest" on the 3rd floor of the Rec Center.
- We've purchased new higher powered mobile radio equipment to use for emergency communications.
- We're changing our radio communications from FRS/GMRS Channel 7 to Channel 15.

WHY?

- The 3rd floor of the Rec Center is a good location for communicating throughout LWC since it is centrally located and our antenna will be elevated.
- Channel 15 will allow us to transmit at a higher power than what is allowed on Channel 7 (about 4x as much). During emergencies that stronger radio signal will be easier to hear throughout LWC.

WHEN?

We will begin using our new radio equipment on Channel 15 during our regular monthly radio communication at 9:00 am on Saturday December 7th.

WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DO?

- If you have one of the several Midland FRS radios that the Safety Committee recommends, you simply change from channel 7 to channel 15 to hear the new radio service. (see attached Midland Radio Instruction sheets). *
- If you are using a programmable radio (e.g., a Baofeng HAM radio) you will need to enter the radio frequency for channel 15 (462.550 MHz) into your radio. *

*If you need help changing to the new channel or entering the new radio frequency your Safety Captains are available to assist you.
