

## **Safety Committee's Pop-Up “Open Garage” Safety Event September 11-14**

In keeping with the Safety Committee’s mission to help all residents be self-sufficient in the event of an emergency, we are offering a **Pop-Up “Open Garage”** safety preparedness opportunity this week to look at one household’s emergency cache and go bags based on Oregon’s Be 2 Weeks Ready and FEMA guidelines.

Please see the attached flyer, and the Safety Committee’s webpage on the LWC website for details about the dates and times this Pop-Up “Open Garage” program is available to all residents September 11-14 at 1250 SW Walking Wood.

We will review a variety of safety equipment and supplies including two-way radios, options for water storage and filtration, non-perishable food, sanitation, first aid, Rx and OTC, and trade tips and information with Safety Captains, friends and neighbors. Information will be available about how to turn off utilities if necessary and what you can do

(in advance) to provide some degree of light, heat, refrigeration, etc. when the power goes out.

The Safety Committee's webpage is the single best source of information about all the resources and projects we are working on to make our residents and our community more knowledgeable and resilient. At the most recent meeting we discussed the Table Top Exercise we will conduct on September 25th based on a (5) day power outage, and the proposal we are developing to upgrade our radio equipment to provide more effective and consistent coverage throughout the community.
