Safety Committee Year End Report

- Developed an accessible, robust <u>Emergency Preparedness</u> <u>webpage</u> with links to resources, upcoming events and past programs and activities https://lwcha.org/safety-committee/
- Wrote a series of articles for Cove Notes to reinforce the need for each household to develop a sense of situational awareness to the dangers of earthquakes, tsunamis and wildfires, to prepare to be self-reliant and shelter in place in their home for 4-6 weeks with a stockpile of water, non-perishable food, medical and first aid supplies, etc. and to have a go bag ready to evacuate if necessary
- Relocated Safety Operations Center (SOC) to the Rec Center
- Established Community Radio Service (CRS) communications center in 3rd floor Crow's Nest of the Rec Center, linking Safety Captains and residents to critical information both within and outside LWC via two-way radios on Channel 15.
- Purchased upgraded radio equipment to increase the ability to broadcast effectively throughout the community
- Formalized Incident Command structure of BoD members, Safety Captains and other residents to provide rapid response to emergencies
- Conducted (4) table top exercises (TTX) with power outages and wildfires scenarios, and developed protocols to prepare for and manage those situations
- Partnered with the City of Depoe Bay to discuss the potential role of LWC as one of five projected islands of the City for emergency planning purposes.
