AAR for Partial LWC Power Outage

0730 - 1430, 04-Aug-2025

Timeline

- Residents reported hearing a "transformer blow" at 0720 and this is noted in the comments on the CLPUD Facebook page.
- According to CLPUD Facebook page, they were aware of the problem at 0740 and dispatched a technician to investigate.
- At 0820, Paul Caldron (SA #4) called MT to see if he had power, and he responded that he did. Paul said he heard some radio communications that others were experiencing the outage.
- MT initiated the CRS at about 0845 from SA #13 with a handheld radio (HT) at 5 watts and started receiving reports from other areas and decided to continue from the Com Center.
- MT arrived at the Rec Center at ~0845, the front door was propped open suggesting the door lock was not working (i.e., the AC power was out). Pat Hossle and Vicky Berchou reported that <u>parts</u> of the Rec Center (including the pool) were without power.
- MT started conducting the first official radio poll at 0855 PDT using the Com Center Wouxun radio transmitting at 20 watts.
- The responses were recorded on an Event Log (refer to attached page at the end of the AAR).
- Following the poll, we established that power was off in the following Safety




Figure 1 – LWC power outages (red pins) by Safety Area at 0914 PDT.

 Areas (in addition to part of the Rec Center): 1, 2, 4, 5, and 11 (refer to Figure 1
 of the LWC Safety Area Map where red pins indicate SAs without power at 0914;
 note SA #10 is not marked with a red pin because only parts of the Rec Center
 were without power and no one in SA #10 indicated they were without power).
- Earle Rother (SA #5) reported that the CLPUD technician was onsite and attempting to identify the problem.
- Reports and information continued to be exchanged throughout the power outage.




Figure 2 – LWC power outages (red pins) by Safety Area at 0942 PDT.

- At 0942, Safety Areas 1, 2, and 11 reported that power was restored. Paul Caldron in SA #4 reported he had power, but Rod Scher reported he was still without power (Figure 2).
- At 0954, MT advised Rod that CLPUD reported all power was restored (which now included SA #5) and that he should consider contacting them to let them know he was still without power. Shortly after this, the CLPUD outage map indicated that there were 4 reported outages along Walking Wood (which included Rod Scher's location).

- MT opted to shut down the CRS shortly thereafter as most people had turned off their radios.




Figure 3 – CLPUD Power Outage Map as of 1342 PDT.




Figure 4 – Zoomed in version of Figure 3 above showing outages along Walking Wood.

- As of 1340, the CLPUD Outage Map still indicated that there were 4 power outages remaining along Walking Wood (Figures 3 and 4).
- By about 1430, the CLPUD Outage Map indicated that there were no more outages in LWC.

Lessons Learned

- Even relatively minor events warrant activation of the CRS and anyone should feel free to call or text a member of the Communications Group (as Paul Caldron did) to inform them of an event or any other GMRS-licensed Safety Captain that can use the Com Center base radio.
- As soon as a member of the Communications Group is aware of the event, they should immediately start transmitting from their home on a GMRS HT (handheld radio) at 5 watts, but announce that they will be relocating to the Com Center to

- use the 20-watt base radio (while MT did begin transmitting first with an HT and then relocated to the Com Center, he did not announce his intent to relocate).
- Notify Anne Bradley (Safety Committee Chair) and Paul Banas (BoD Chair) via text to apprise and let them decide if ICS activation is warranted immediately or possibly later (this was not done).
- Presumably everyone in a Safety Area knows who their Safety Captain is and that the captains can get on a 5-watt HT (at a minimum); however, perhaps we should make a list available (with names and phone numbers) of those people that have GMRS licenses and can operate the 20-watt Com Center base radio (and have access to the Com Center). Eventually, this could be added to the Resident Directory.
- Find out if there is some way to talk to a CLPUD technician directly via GMRS radio. CLPUD may be reluctant to talk to us, but it might help them if they know we do transmit on GMRS Channel 15 so they can listen in.
- The LWC Safety Area Status Map with color-coded magnetic pins worked. We might consider purchasing additional colored pins (particularly red) so we could actually mark any specific parcel that reports in regarding problematic status.
- Per Paul Caldron, contact CLPUD and see if they can provide a map showing which areas of LWC are covered by the three incoming power lines given that these areas do not coincide with our Safety Areas. This should probably come from Paul Banas or Anne Bradley.
- It would be handy to have someone with the radio operator taking notes. Times
 and information would be more accurate. It is difficult to transmit and receive
 information on the radio and write at the same time. Moreover, the Event Log
 works initially, but becomes cumbersome should an event extend beyond an
 hour. If subsequent polls are conducted, the form would work, otherwise a simple
 blank log might suffice, but again with a scribe.
