Hwy 101 at Big Whale Cove. This section of the highway was almost breached during the tsunami of March 11, 2011. ODOT spent several days adding rock and soil material to an eroded scarp that was dangerously close to causing roadbed failure.

A future CSZ earthquake and tsunami will likely destroy Hwy 101 at this location.
