

Preparing for a Power Outage

The Safety Committee will host a workshop on Saturday, December 6, 2-4 PM at the Rec Center to help residents prepare for a power outage. Based on positive feedback from previous sessions, we will focus on (3) topics:

- Buying and learning to use a two-way radio to receive information from our Community Radio Service (CRS) so you can shelter in place in your home during an emergency
- Buying and learning to use and maintain a portable generator
- Developing a household cache of alternative ways to provide light and warmth, prepare food, charge devices, etc.

Following a (15) minute overview of these topics, you will have an opportunity to look at emergency supplies for a household cache, use a two-way radio and operate a portable generator in the parking lot. Additional information about these topics is on our [Safety Committee webpage](#).
